Dear Donors, Sponsors and friends of BHIK-U,

Love and sincere regards to all of you. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for all you have done



to support BHIK-U since the inception. God is watching and has blessed our efforts in ways I cannot explain. Progress is amazing. Below is a summary of what is on the ground right now:

1. Dining/Multi purpose hall/ teachers' accomodations now is ready for painting; we will need to concentrate on getting it furnished (furniture etc).

2. Classroom block/ temporary dormitories plastering is at about 75% complete; it will soon need furnishings as well.

3. Administration block is roofed; plastering will start soon.

4. Work on the kitchen and external latrines is ongoing concurrently. These structures will also need furnishings.

I project that by the end of September all construction will be done. As we get closer to realizing our dream as each day passes by, we still need your help.

We need more funds to complete construction and stock the school. We need more sponsors for students (we need sponsors for 125 students; donating \$50 per month will achieve this). We will grant naming rights to those who sponsor dorm rooms (\$640) & classrooms (\$3000). Please prayerfully consider changing the life of a needy student by choosing an area above where you can support us.

There's a lot of excitement from the neighbors about the upcoming beautiful school. Our target is to open the school in February 2019. Please keep this project in your prayers.

Thanks again for your support. I send you choice blessings.



- Tentative dates: July 22 August 3, 2019
- Limited to 14-16 people
- Approximately 10 days in Uganda, 3 days travel to & from Uganda
- Anticipated cost: \$3500 per person, including airfare (from Chicago), room & board, and vaccinations *NOTE: Price is an estimate based on current airfare, etc. More accurate pricing and more detailed information will be sent closer to the departure date.*
- Might include:
 - "hands-on" work at the school site



- the chance to meet teachers, staff, & students
- celebration of Father's 21st anniversary of ordination
- "official" school dedication ceremony
- scenic tour of Queen Elizabeth National Park, Lake Bunyonyi, and more

FROM THE DESK OF BHIK-U BOARD PRESIDENT, JOHN GRILLOT

Phase 1 of our school construction is nearing completion. Fr. Julius has been extremely effective in achieving so much with the funds that were raised over the last couple of years. Our February 2019 opening is very much on target.

We are still in much need of additional funds as we continue toward Phase 2 of the plan that includes dedicated dormitories for the students (initially they will sleep in upper level of the classroom building). In addition to cash donations, several donation opportunities for you to consider include matching gifts from employers (such as State Farm & John Deere), donations of appreciated stocks/bonds (significant tax advantages for the donor), and donations of RMD (Required Minimum Distributions) from retirement accounts.

My wife, Kay, and I will be traveling to Uganda next month to visit the school site and meet with Fr. Julius. We are excited about the trip and about seeing the school first hand. I look forward to reporting back about the trip. Please contact me if you have a card or note to deliver.
